

CMA STANDARDISED PRICE LIST - BASIC FUNERAL

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this price list for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary)

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)	
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation	
Taking care of the necessary legal and minimum arrangements ***	£1,500.00
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death within 15 miles of funeral director's premises ***	£235.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at both funeral director's branch and other non branch premises	£295.00
Providing a basic foil veneer coffin ***	£190.00
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer) ***	included
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in an appropriate vehicle ***	£235.00
TOTAL	£2,455.00
UNATTENDED FUNERAL	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation	
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1,285.00
Cremation (funeral directors charges plus the cremation fee**)	£2,050.00
FEES YOU MUST PAY	
For an Attended or Unattended Simple burial funeral at a local cemetery, the burial fee *	
In this area, the typical cost for local residents is	£800 - £1,550
For a new grave, you will need to pay for the plot, for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition the cemetery may charge a number of other fees	
For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee **	
In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is	£950 - £1,200
Please discuss any specific religious, belief based and/or cultural requirements that you have with the funeral director.	
ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES -	
This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include	
Additional mileage (Price per mile)	£2.50
Additional transfer of coffin into home or church prior to the funeral	£550.00
Embalming	£210.00
PAYMENTS MADE ON CLIENT'S BEHALF (disbursements / third party fees)	
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc)	
Appx	£255.00
Church fees (inc minister, organist and verger)	
Appx	£495.00
The funeral director can give you a full list of what they supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can choose a different supplier.	

* This fee (which is sometime called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

** In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign Medical Certificates for Cremation.
